






## AWARENESS DRIVES ABLING BEHAVIOUR CHANGE

Our Legal research team is focussed on filing a Public Interest Litigation (PIL) before the Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka, seeking to:


- Restrict the movement of smoke emitting vehicles
- Provide traffic policemen with antipollution masks
- Empower traffic policemen with handheld devices for monitoring the emissions of all vehicles on road
- Increase the number of PUC testing centres
- Increase the number of air pollution monitoring stations

Additionally, we send out RTIs, research on Global laws and policies related to air pollution; and are in constant touch with city traffic deptartments & Pollution Control Boards.

### DID YOU KNOW?

Under rule 115 & 116 of the Central Motor Vehicle Rules (1989), authorities are empowered to suspend the certificate of registration of vehicles that do not comply with emission standards. Although we see hundreds of smoke emitting vehilces plying on our roads, in the past ten years, not a single certificate has been suspended in various CA cities!
